INTERNATIONAL PHILOSOPHIC OLYMPIAD 2010

General information about the IPO

The 18th International Philosophy Olympiad in Athens is organized by The Harvard University's Center for Hellenic Studies in collaboration with University of Patras and the Greek Chapter of the IPO Committee. This event is hosted under the aegis of the Greek Ministry of Education and sponsored by the Ministry of Greek Culture and Tourism – Greek National Tourism Organization (EOT).

Approximately 26 international delegations have been invited to this year's competition. All costs for full-board accommodation between the 21st (the 20th of May can also be covered, in the case of non-European participants) and the 23rd of May will be covered by the organizers. There will be ground transportation provided for delegation members during the days of the Olympiad (including transfers to and from the airport and to all event venues included in the IPO 2010 program).

The ATExcelixi Training and Conference Center, in Athens, will be the IPO 2010 headquarters, where the Opening Ceremony and examinations will be hosted. The ATExcelixi Training and Conference Center is located in Nea Erythrea, in the northern suburbs of Athens, approximately 20 kilometers from city center of Athens and 3 kilometers from the city center of Kifissia.
